

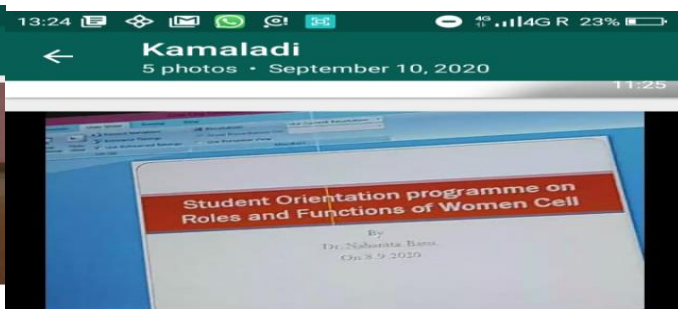
Students Orientation Programme Report
